

## ProServices Supply Arrangement Overview

The Government of Canada purchases professional services through contract vehicles such as standing offers (SO) and supply arrangements (SA). In some cases, the use of an SO or SA is mandatory. For professional services contracts under \$89,600, the ProServices SA is an essential contract vehicle and will be for years to come. The other related mandatory contract vehicles include the Task and Solutions Professional Services (TSPS) Task-Based SO, the TSPS Task-Based SA, the Task-Based Informatics Professional Services (TBIPS) SO, the TBIPS SA, the TSPS Solutions-Based SA, and the Solutions-Based Informatics Professional Services (SBIPS) SA.
