

Ontario I&IT Solutions Consulting Services VOR Overview

The Government of Ontario purchases IT Professional Services through a Vendor of Record (VOR) Arrangement. This VOR is similar to a Supply Arrangement and is used by all Government of Ontario ministries and other entities to procure a range of IT Professional Services. The I&IT Solutions Consulting Services VOR is a mandatory contract vehicle for contracts involving a complete end-to-end, fixed price, Information Technology Professional Services Solution. This VOR is mandatory for Government of Ontario ministries and for Ontario Public Service (OPS) entities that wish to obtain such professional services. It is optional for Provincially Funded Organizations (PFO), (which include but are not limited to municipalities, hospitals, and school boards).

<p>Ontario I&IT Solutions Consulting Services Vendor of Record (VOR) The ON I&IT Solutions Consulting Services VOR is a Government of Ontario mandatory procurement tool for buying IT professional services in the form of a fixed-price solution.</p> <p>There are two streams:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stream A: Projects under \$5 Million • Stream B: Projects over \$5 Million <p>By qualifying for this VOR, your firm will become eligible to provide I&IT Solutions Consulting Services to the Ontario government in the stream you qualify for. Specific contracts will typically be awarded using a best value (technical + financial) evaluation.</p>	<p>The 2019 I&IT Solutions Consulting Services VOR is currently open and will replace the corresponding 2015 VOR requiring all existing vendors to submit a proposal (may use an attestation process) and providing an opportunity for new bidders to qualify. The solicitation closes on November 20, 2018.</p> <p><u>Key Criteria (for new bidders):</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completed Form of Offer • A Resource Plan that addresses 13-questions regarding your management processes and practices • Project Profiles (Two for Stream A; Three for Stream B) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Must have been <i>completed</i> between November 1, 2013 and October 5, 2018 ○ Must have a minimum duration of 30 days ○ STREAM B ONLY – Must have minimum value of \$5 Million. ○ Must have involved Business Analysis & Planning; Architecture; Solutions Development; Testing & Quality Assurance, and Systems Integration/Deployment & Operations. ○ You must have been responsible for managing and retaining responsibility for, and control over the work of, your personnel, subcontractors and other resources. ○ You must provide detailed information about the work performed and methodologies used ○ The client reference must review and sign the profile and verification sheet, and complete a questionnaire about your performance on the project. <p>The proposal is to be submitted electronically online through Ontario's electronic tendering system, BravoSolution.</p>
