

PWGSC THS for the NCR SA Overview

The Government of Canada purchases professional services through contract vehicles such as standing offers (SO) and supply arrangements (SA). In some cases, the use of an SO or SA is mandatory. The Temporary Help Services (THS) for the National Capital Region (NCR) SA is the mandatory contract vehicle for the services of a resource in the NCR in response to one of the following situations:

- When a public servant is absent for a temporary period of time
- When a requirement exists for additional staff during a temporary workload increase, in which there is an insufficient number of public servants available to meet the requirement
- When a position is vacant and staffing action is being completed
